

ORDINANCE NO. 83-6

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING HERNANDO COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 83-4, "AN ORDINANCE OF HERNANDO COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO PROHIBIT OR CURTAIL CERTAIN NON-ESSENTIAL USES OF WATER WITHIN THE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS OWNED BY HERNANDO COUNTY THROUGH THE HERNANDO COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, AND TO CONSERVE AVAILABLE WATER RESOURCES DURING A DECLARED WATER SHORTAGE AND WATER SHORTAGE EMERGENCY; DEFINING THE TERMS PERTAINING THERETO; PROVIDING FOR APPLICATION OF ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR EXCEPTIONS, APPEAL PROCEDURES AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR EMERGENCY ADOPTION; AND FOR THE PURPOSES"

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Hernando County Ordinance No. 83-4, adopted as an emergency ordinance by the Board of County Commissioners in Regular Session on May 23, 1983, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is adopted as an emergency ordinance as a result of the termination of the emergency situation which previously existed.
