

**ORDINANCE NO.: 91-16**

***AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CLERK OF THE COURT TO PROVIDE LIST OF PERSONS WITH THREE OR MORE OUTSTANDING TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE COUNTY CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.***

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:

**SECTION I.**

Pursuant to Section 316.1967, Florida Statutes, the Clerk of Court shall supply the Florida Department of Motor Vehicles a list, in the prescribed format, listing persons who have three or more outstanding parking violations.

**SECTION II.**

Pursuant to Section 320.03(8), if the name of an applicant for a vehicle license plate or revalidation sticker, name appears on the above list, no such license or sticker shall be issued until such person's name no longer appears on said list or until such person presents a receipt from the Clerk, showing that such parking fines have been paid.

**SECTION III.**

The Tax Collector and Clerk of the Court shall each be entitled to receive monthly, as cost for implementing and administering this ordinance, ten (10%) percent of civil fines and penalties recovered from such person.

**SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, or administrative agency, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and except as otherwise expressly provided herein, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof, all of which will remain in full force and effect, except as otherwise provided for

herein.

**SECTION V. INCLUSION IN THE CODE**

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida and it is hereby provided that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the sections of this Ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or other appropriate designation.

**SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall become effective upon receipt of official acknowledgment from the Secretary of State that said Ordinance has been filed.
