

ORDINANCE NO. 76-8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 74-2 BY CREATING A LAW LIBRARY FUND; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOSING OF A SERVICE CHARGE UPON FILING OF CIVIL CASES TO BE USED TO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN A LAW LIBRARY; PROVIDING FOR IMPOSING OF A SERVICE CHARGE UPON FILING OF CRIMINAL CASES TO BE USED TO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN A LAW LIBRARY; ESTABLISHING THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT AS CUSTODIAN OF SAID FUND; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created within Hernando County, Florida, a law library fund, which fund shall be used for the providing and maintaining of a law library within the Hernando County Courthouse or any annex thereof.

SECTION 2. There is hereby imposed a service charge of FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00), which shall be paid by the party instituting any civil action, suit or proceeding in the Circuit Court of Hernando County, Florida, to the Clerk of said Court in addition to any other service charges authorized by law. Said service charge shall be paid into the law library fund and shall be used exclusively for the providing and maintaining of a law library within the County.

SECTION 3. There is hereby imposed a service charge of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00), which shall be paid by the party instituting any civil action, suit or proceeding in the County Court of Hernando County, Florida, to the Clerk of said Court in addition to any other service charges authorized by law. Said service charge shall be paid into the law library fund and shall be used exclusively for the providing and maintaining of a law library within the County.


SECTION 4. The Clerk of the Circuit Court shall be the custodian of the law library fund herein created and shall be responsible for the providing, maintaining and operating of the law library herein authorized.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
