

ORDINANCE NO. 75-1

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OPEN DUMPING AND OTHER SOLID TRASH DISPOSAL WITHIN HERNANDO COUNTY; ESTABLISHING LIABILITY OF THE ORIGINATOR OF GARBAGE AND OTHER SOLID WASTE MATERIALS; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

SECTION 1. The open dumping or disposal of garbage, trash, litter, solid waste materials and all other forms of matter or thing being disposed of or abandoned, within the geographic boundaries of Hernando County, in any area other than an approved solid waste landfill site, is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2. It shall be prima facia evidence of a violation of this Ordinance if the disposed of or abandoned material, as outlined in Section 1, can be established as having originated with a particular individual and he has allowed it to be so dumped, discarded or abandoned in an area other than an approved solid waste landfill, unless such individual has contracted for the disposal of his waste materials with an approved garbage franchisee.

SECTION 3. A violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment up to sixty days in the County Jail, or both.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is passed as an emergency ordinance under the provisions applicable to emergency ordinances in Chapter 125 of Florida Statutes and shall become effective upon mailing a copy of this Ordinance to the Secretary of State, Tallahassee, Florida.

ADOPTED as an emergency ordinance by four-fifths (4/5) vote of the Board of County Commissioners, in Regular Session, on the 11th day of March, 1975.
