15	Section 1. Designation of Sheriff as Chief Correctional Officer. A new section of the

The Sheriff shall include salaries for correctional officers in his/her 1 D. 2 annual proposed budget of expenditures for the maintenance and operation of the 3 county's jail(s) as provided in Fla. Stat. § 30.49. The salaries for correctional officers 4 shall be paid from the general revenue fund of Hernando County. 5 Section 2. Severability. 6 It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section, 7 subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held 8 unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining 9 portions of this ordinance. 10 Section 3. Inclusion in the Code. 11 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the 12 13 Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, any section or subsection of this 14 Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section, "article", or other appropriate designation. 15 16 Section 4. Repeal of Ordinances in Conflict. 17 Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. Section 5. 18 **Effective Date.** 19 This ordinance shall take effect on August 27, 2010.
